REINSTATEMENT OF SCHOOL OF MEDICINE PROGRAMMES AT CAVENDISH UNIVERSITY ZAMBIA (CUZ)

Cavendish University Zambia (CUZ) is delighted to inform all stakeholders that the three programmes that were recently withdrawn at CUZ by the Health Professions Council of Zambia (HPCZ) have been reinstated by HPCZ as of 17 September 2018. Following HPCZ programme reinstatements, the affected students in these programmes at the CUZ School of Medicine are required to proceed as follows:

- New and continuing students for Bachelor of Clinical Sciences (BCSc) and the Master of Public Health (MPH) should register as soon as possible for the start of classes on Monday, 24 September 2018.
- Only continuing students in the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBChB) are required to register as soon as possible for the start of classes on Monday, 24 September 2018.
- New students for the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBChB) will only start classes when the CUZ pre-clinical labs move from their current shared location to the CUZ School of Medicine campus in 2019.

The delayed academic calendar for these three programmes will run from 24 September 2018 to 30 January 2019.

CUZ is highly appreciative to HPCZ for its professional guidance which has led to major improvements at the CUZ School of Medicine that now include having one of the best medical skills simulation labs in the region.

CUZ is very grateful to its students, parents, guardians, student-sponsors and other stakeholders for their patience and support during the temporary withdrawal of the three licenses.
